Brother of Israeli held by Hezbollah in San Francisco

San Francisco (CA): Gadi Goldwasser, younger brother of captured Israeli soldier Ehud Goldwasser, will be in San Francisco to talk about his brother's plight and keep it before the eyes of the world.

Ever since the abduction of Ehud by Hezbollah – the incident that touched off this summer's Middle East war – Gadi has devoted his time and energy to working for his brother's release. On September 20, he addressed the UN General Assembly in New York with regard to his brother's abduction and called upon world leaders to help bring the captured Israeli soldiers back home safely.

On July 12, 2006, Hezbollah infiltrators attacked Ehud's routine patrol, which was on the Israeli side of the Israel-Lebanon border. As a result, eight Israeli soldiers were killed and Ehud, as well as Eldad Regev, were abducted and are still being held.
